Type of Virtual Visit	Service provided	Codes
Audio and Video Visit, new and established patients	Audio virtual visit plus Video (counts if even only for part of the visit)	Regular E&M codes  Remember physical bullet points in general: 99202=99213 and 99203=99214
Audio only Visit, new and established patients	Only able to do the Audio portion	Bill telephonic patient codes only:  99441 – 5-10 minutes  99442 – 11-20 minutes  99443 – 21-30 minutes  *Time-based codes can be used by Physicians and APPs. Total time should be the overall time the provider spends talking with the patient; MA time is not to be included in the total time.
